### **MEC MOKGETHI TO VISIT VACCINATION SITES IN TSHWANE**

The Gauteng MEC for Health Dr Nomathemba Mokgethi will today, (31 July) conduct oversight visit at Olievenhoutbosch and Atteridgeville vaccination sites.

The Gauteng Provincial Government has expanded the number of vaccination sites that are operational this weekend (31 July – 1 August 2021) from 4 to 16 sites. Eight of those Vaccination sites are in Tshwane District.

The sites are spread across 4 of the 5 districts in the province. Gauteng public vaccinations sites accept walk-ins whether people are registered on the EVDS or not.
