MEC Mamabolo to officially launch multi-million Allandale Road construction project

Gauteng MEC for Public Transport and Roads Infrastructure, Jacob Mamabolo, will on Friday, 04 March 2022, officiate the sod-turning ceremony inaugurating the Road K73 (Allandale Road) construction project in Midrand.

More than R300 million has been earmarked for the construction of a twin carriageway of the new K73 between Montrose Road and Allandale Road (K58) as well as the upgrading of a section of the K71 (Woodmead Drive).

The scope of work also includes the construction of a bridge on K73, extension of existing culverts and the construction of new ones on K58, relocation of existing services, landscaping, supply and installation of guard rails and street lights, construction of kerbs, and work such as road signs and road markings.

This event is in line with the Gauteng Provincial Government's province-wide 2022 EXCO Ntirhisano Outreach Programmes.

The programme is an integrated, comprehensive, and sustainable effort to radically restructure the interface between government and the people in order to better cater to their needs.
