The Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport adhere to all relevant Acts including, the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa of 1996 the Black Economic Empowerment Act No.53 of 2003, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No.5 of 2000, Employment Equity Act No. 55 of 1998 and the Public Finance Management Act, No 1 of 1999.

NB: Tenderers who are listed on the National Treasury's register of defaulters and restricted suppliers will be automatically disqualified.

Recommended bidders will be subjected to security screening/vetting in line with the Minimum Information Security Standards (MISS) and National Strategic Intelligence Amendment Act No 67 of 2002. Negative result will render the bidder automatically disqualified. **PRE-**QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT

The Department has decided to apply pre-qualifying criteria, in terms of Preferential Procurement Regulation 4.(1)(a) to advance certain designated groups. Service Providers who do not meet the pre-qualification criteria, will be disqualified and will not be considered for further evaluation. Only the following may respond: • Service Providers must be a minimum B-BBEE status level 1 or 2 contributor

COMPULSORY/MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS: Failure to submit and comply with the following mandatory required documents will render the service providers non-responsive and the service providers will be disqualified from further evaluation: • Roving Supervisor must submit certified copies of grade 12 Senior certificate, Grade A security registration number with Psira. Prospective bidders must be active/in good standing with Psira before tender closing. • Service Provider must be registered and in good standing/active with PSIRA Bidders must attend the compulsory site briefing as indicated above. The attendance register must be completed and will be used as proof of your attendance.
 Complete and signed all SBD documents (SBD 4, SBD 6.1 and SBD 6.2) which form part of the tender document. • Local production and content threshold requirements: (failure to submit the fully completed and signed SBD 6.2 and Annexure C will lead to disqualification). Bidders must comply with the stipulated local content thresholds failing which will lead to disqualification. Prospective bidders should be represented at the briefing session by suitable/qualified and experienced individuals who can fully comprehend the scope and complexities of the work

OTHER KEY RETURNABLES: • Bidders must submit their SARS TCS PIN number and CSD Supplier number with their bid in order that the bidder's Tax Compliance Status can be verified. Should a bidder not be Tax Compliant at the time of verification, the bidder will be notified in writing of their non-compliant tax status and be requested to remediate their tax status within seven (7) working days. Failure to provide written proof of tax status remediation, within seven (7) working days of notification, will result in the rejection of the bid submitted by the Bidder • Registration Documents of the business with the Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) OR Master of the High Court in South Africa.

FUNCTIONALITY EVALUATION: Functionality will be scored out of 100 points and the minimum threshold to qualify is 70 points. Bidders who fail to meet the minimum threshold will not be considered for further evaluation. The functionality evaluation criteria

The tenderer's bid submission will not be considered and regarded as nonresponsive, if: 1.1 The tenderer has three (3) or more current contracts in progress with the Department that have not been certified as complete, at the time of tender closure T.2. The tenderer has contracts in progress with a cumulative total value in excess of R250 million (including all applicable taxes) with the Department, which have a cumulative contractual period of more than 12 months and have not been certified as complete, at the time of tender closure. 2. The Department will apply their work spread model as objective criteria to multiple tenderers, irrespective of highest total number of points scored, which comprises the following: 2.1 A tenderer will not be awarded more than two (2) bills of worth (contracts). PRICE AND PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEM EVALUATION: The Department will be applying the 80/20 or 90/10 (all categories) preference point system. • The Amended Construction Sector Code issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, Act 53 of 2003 as amended by the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Amendment Act, Act No. 46 of 2013. B-BBEE certificates that do not confirm to the Amended Construction Sector Code will be declared invalid.

Service Providers should note the following: • Where the proposed prices or rat materials/services to be supplied to the Department are considerably less than the expected market price or rates, the Department reserves the right to verify the proposed prices or rates

\*The Department reserves the right to conduct site visits and interview tenderer's staff whose qualifications have been submitted for verification. • Only Service Providers including JV partners and consortium members, including sub-contractors, who are registered on the National Centralised Supplier Database (CSD) will be considered for appointment. • Service Providers must note that in terms of Departmental policy, the Department reserves the right

to cancel a contract and blacklist any contractor for a period of at least 12 months if the contractor fails to adequately perform in terms of the awarded contract. • The Service Provide validity period is 90 days. However, the Department reserves the right to request all Service Providers to extend such validity period should the need arise. The successful Service Provider will be required to enter into a formal contract with the Department. The Department will not compensate the tenderer for any costs incurred in the preparation and submission of a tender, including the costs of any testing necessary to demonstrate that aspect of the offer complies with requirements.
