Security guarding services at all GDRT premises (sites)

On the 22 July 2022, the Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport invited Tenderers to bid for Security guarding services at all GDRT premises (sites) by advertising in the Press (The Star and Sowetan and eTender Portal).

Notice is hereby given of amendments to the tender already advertised in respect of the following:

1. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT

The Department has decided to apply pre-qualifying criteria, in terms of Preferential Procurement Regulation 4.1(a) to advance certain designated groups. Service Providers who do not meet the pre-qualification criteria, will be disqualified and will not be considered for further evaluation. Only the following may respond:

- **Service Providers must be a minimum B-BBEE status level 1 or 2 contributor**

Qualifying EME's or QSE's must adhere to the following:

1. A Service Provider who qualifies as an Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME's) must submit a sworn affidavit.
2. A Service Provider who qualifies as a Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE's) and is more than 51% black owned must submit a sworn affidavit.
3. Sworn affidavits submitted by bidders in support of their B-BBEE level should comply with the DTI or the CIPC format or in a similar format and must be valid, original or certified as a true copy of the original.
4. A Service Provider who qualifies as a Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE's) and is less than 51% black owned must submit a B-BBEE verification certificate issued by an Agency accredited by SANAS (South African National Accreditation System) which has to be valid, original or certified as a true copy of the original. In addition, the Bidder must submit an affidavit stipulating that their annual Total Revenue was between R10,000,000.00 (Ten Million Rand) and R50,000,000.00 (Fifty Million Rand) based on their latest Financial Statements/Management Accounts and other information available thereon.
5. Service Providers who do NOT qualify as EME's and QSE's as outlined in 1 and 2 above, must submit B-BBEE verification certificates that are issued by an Agency accredited by SANAS.
6. A trust, consortium or joint venture (including unincorporated consortia and joint ventures) must submit a consolidated B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificate for every separate tender.
7. Public entities and tertiary institutions must also submit B-BBEE Status Level Verification Certificates together with their tenders.

Service Providers who fail to submit a valid B-BBEE Certificate or original/certified Sworn Affidavit will be regarded as non-responsive bidders and be disqualified. Sworn Affidavits and certification as a "true copy of the original", must comply with the requirements outlined in the Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act, No 16 of 1963 and its Regulations promulgated in Government Notice GNR 1258 of 21 July 1972 Justices of the Peace and Commissioners of Oaths Act, No. 16 of 1963.

NB: The submission of a fraudulent B-BBEE certificate and / or Sworn Affidavit will result in the bidder being disqualified and criminal proceedings being instituted against the bidder. The bidder, the shareholders and / or directors will further be restricted from doing business with any organ of the state for a maximum period of 10
