GAUTENG ADMINISTERED VACCINATIONS DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

A total of 5 918 374 COVID-19 vaccinations have been administered in the province as at 28 October 2021.

As at 28 October 2021 a total number of individuals vaccinated is 3 902 577 and individuals fully vaccinated sits at 2 977 311.
