### **GAUTENG HEALTH MEC DR BANDILE MASUKU TO UNVEIL DONATED VEHICLES FOR COVID-19**

The Gauteng Health MEC Dr Bandile Masuku will today, (Friday, 10 April 2020) unveil six vehicles donated by Peugeot to aid in the fight against COVID-19.

The donation comes a day after President Cyril Ramaphosa announced that government will be intensifying public health response to slow down and reduce Coronavirus infections.

This will see government speeding up the roll out of the community screening and testing programme focusing in particular on highly vulnerable communities.

The vehicles donation will help the Gauteng Province which is South Africa's epicentre of COVID-19 to improve screening, testing and contact tracing across its five districts.
