The total budget is **R86.9 billion for 2014/15** and increases to **R98.9 billion in the outer year** of the medium term. The following is a list of projects and programmes in relation to the fourteen provincial outcomes:

Quality basic education

- o Provision of learner and teacher support material is **R1.5 billion** in 2014/15.
- o Provision for scholar transport amount to **R338.3 million** in 2014/15.
- o **R2 billion over the MTEF** will provide a daily nutritional meal to needy children.
- Early Childhood Development receives R733.9 million in 2014/15.

Long and healthy life for all South Africans

- o **R2.8 billion** in 2014/15 is allocated towards Comprehensive HIV and AIDS
- o **R1.2 billion** over the medium term for Tuberculosis hospitals

- Emergency Medical Services a total of R1 billion in 2014/15 to provide emergency care and improve response times.
- o Central and tertiary hospitals receive a total of **R10.6 billion** for 2014/15.
- An additional allocation of R1.6 billion over MTEF for the strengthening of Primary Health
 Care

All people in South Africa are and feel safe

- The prevention of Violence against Women and Children (VAWAC) receives R16 million in 2014/15.
- Learnerships for Forensic Social workers through a budget allocation of R2.1 million in 2014/15.

Vibrant and sustainable rural communities

- Maize Triangle project receives **R16.5 million** over the medium term.
- The eradication of alien vegetation is **R36 million** over the medium term.
- Farmer support amounts to **R148 million over the medium term**.
- o Food security projects amounts to **R73 million** over the medium term.

Skilled and capable workforce to support an inclusive growth path

 A total amount of R1 billion over the medium term for the Gauteng City Region Academy inclusive of the Gauteng Master Skills Plan (MSP).

Sustainable human settlements and improved quality of household life

- An amount of R550.2 million is made available the Renewal Programme over the medium term.
- R39.8 million is set aside for Inner City Regeneration in Krugersdorp, Vereeniging and Germiston.

Responsive, accountable, efficient and effective local government

- The preparation of merger of municipalities **R1 million for 2014/15**.
- A total of R39.6 million over the medium term for the Community Development Workers Programme.

 The conceptualization of the Disaster Management Centre which is responsive to the dynamics of a city region with 4 metros is R5 million for 2013/14.

Youth employment and investment opportunities

- R84.6 million is set aside for 2014/15 and R267.5 million over the 2014 MTEF for support of SMME's and Cooperatives.
- Tourism infrastructure with a total budget of R43.3 million over the medium term.

Efficient, effective and development oriented public service, and an empowered, fair and inclusive citizenship

- A total R510 million for the first two years of the medium term for the roll out of Gauteng Broadband Network project.
- o **R40 million** for 2014/15 to fund the Health Intervention Programme.

Nation building and social cohesion

- o R132 million in 2014/15 and R162 million in 2015/16 for the Provincial Archives Centre.
- The budget for the construction of eight community libraries amounts to R83 million in 2014/15; R96.8 million in 2015/16 and R101.9 million in 2016/17 to inculcate a culture of reading and learning.

An efficient, competitive and responsive economic infrastructure network

- R10.4 million for the implementation of non-motorized transport programme (NMT) which
 involves the fitting of walkways and bicycle lanes on existing and new roads which will be
 implemented in Winterveldt and Bophelong.
- The commencement of projects in Vosloorus amounting to R9 million and Kaalfontein amounting R15.8 million.
- R198.3 million for the construction of two new DLTCs in Kagiso and Mamelodi as well as refurbishing the DLTCs currently in operation.

Social protection

Dignity Pack programmes has a budget of R102 million over the medium term.

School uniforms to children in quintile 1 and 2 schools with R95 million in 2014/15.

- The total infrastructure programme amounts to more than R32 billion over the MTEF.
- R15.2 billion over the MTEF is allocated to the Department of Human Settlements for the housing units and houses.
- R6.1 billion over the MTEF is allocated to the Department of Roads and Transport for roads and public transport facilities
- The Department of Health receives R4.4 billion over the MTEF health infrastructure including hospitals, clinics and community health centres
- The Department of Education receives R4.8 billion over the MTEF for education infrastructure requirements.
- An amount of R180 million is allocated to Infrastructure Development to complete Phase 2 of the Women's Monument Project.

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
