Gauteng government takes Smart Mobility Weekends to Sedibeng

The Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport will on Friday, 23 April 2021, take its road infrastructure maintenance drive, **#SmartMobilityWeekends** Campaign, to the Sedibeng District Municipality.
