Gauteng Government to unveil recommissioned John Ware Open Gas Turbine

16 April 2024

The Gauteng Provincial Government in partnership with City Power, an implementing agent of the Gauteng Energy Response Plan will on Wednesday, 17 April 2024 unveil the recommissioned open gas turbine at the John Ware substation.

The launch of the substation forms part of the provincial government's energy plan to add 100 megawatts of electricity to the grid to mitigate the impact of load shedding in Gauteng. The substation, which will be renamed after the late City of Johannesburg Mayor, Mpho Moerane will generate 50 MW of electricity into the grid.

Gauteng Premier Panyaza Lesufi accompanied by Johannesburg Mayor Kabelo Gwamanda, and MMC for Environmental Services, Councillor Jack Sekwaila will join City Power board Chairperson Bonolo Ramokhele and CEO Ms Tshifularo Mashava at the launch of the project.
