Applicants must show proof of admission (provisional admission) to a higher educational

 Have been a permanent resident in the Gauteng Province for at least one-year prior to application. Studying or intending to study full time at a recognised institution of higher
- learning in Gauteng Province.
- Preference will be given to those who excel academically and/or demonstrate potential.
 Preference will be given to those who are not currently benefiting from any other bursary
- scheme. Women, people with disabilities and people living in designated rural areas/nodes are encouraged to apply.
- If you do not receive a response from the Department by the end of January 2020, consider your application unsuccessful.
