INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

What is an internship programme?

There are two types of internship programmes within Government which are described below:

GRADUATE INTERNSHIP

This programme is offered to a person who has completed a qualification and is unemployed but requires workplace experience to enhance future employment opportunities.

STUDENT INTERNSHIP OR WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING

This programme is offered to a person who is currently studying towards a higher education qualification and must undertake a period of work experience to fulfil the requirements of the qualification.

Who qualifies for an internship?

Any South African citizen graduate or undergraduate, who requires experiential training to obtain a certain qualification

Graduates who have no prior working experience

Applicant must be between the ages of 18 and 35

Minimum requirement to obtain an internship

Curriculum Vitae

Certified copy of South African ID

Certified copy of Matric certificate

Certified copy of academic record/Certificate /N. Dip/Degree

Certified copy of proof of registration (for 3rd year students who have remaining subjects to complete a qualification)

The Department will advertise internship positions by 30 September each year. All graduate and student (WIL) interns should apply during this period for an intake in the next year.

Short-listed candidates will be required to attend an interview as part of the selection process.
