Emfuleni Local Municipality (ELM) Administrators to report on the state of Emfuleni Local Municipality

On 13 June 2018, the Gauteng Executive Council (EXCO) took a decision to invoke the provisions of section 139(1)(b)(i) and 5(a) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, Act No. 108 of 1996, regarding Emfuleni Local Municipality. While some progress has been made, the intervention has not produced the desired outcomes in respect of the following areas: (a) Supply chain management; (b) Finance, and (c) Infrastructure / Service Delivery. After a considered review of the 2018 intervention, EXCO resolved in July 2020 to appoint new Administrators to focus specifically on the three areas mentioned above.

On Tuesday, 18 May 2021, the four administrators will report on the refocused priorities and account to the public on the progress made, the challenges that remain and the proposed solutions.
