Gauteng Government Ramps Up CBD Friday Interventions at Constitution Hill

The deterioration of Gauteng's historic Central Business Districts (CBDs) remains a pressing challenge, demanding urgent intervention and collaboration between the public and private sectors. These once-thriving economic hubs hold immense potential to drive spatial transformation and economic revitalisation.

Building on the momentum of successful activations last year, the next CBD Friday intervention will take place on Friday, 14 February 2025, with a strong focus on Constitution Hill in Johannesburg. Activities will include litter removal, streetlight repairs, enhanced safety and security measures, and social services support for the surrounding communities.

This initiative is led by the Gauteng Provincial Government, in partnership with the **South African Local Government Association (SALGA)**, the **City of Johannesburg Metropolitan Municipality**, and civil movement **Jozi My Jozi**. It forms part of the broader CBD Revitalisation Programme, launched on 30 August 2024, which seeks to combat urban decay and crime while improving lighting, security, and cleanliness to create a more attractive environment for investment.
