**MEC MAMABOLO TO TABLE INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT AND COGTA
2023/2024 ANNUAL REPORTS AT THE PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE**

Gauteng MEC for Infrastructure Development and Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs (CoGTA), Mr Jacob Mamabolo, will present the 2023/2024 Annual Report at the Provincial Legislature tomorrow, 5th September 2024. The presentation will highlight the performance milestones achieved by both Departments during the financial year under review.

The Department of Infrastructure Development is tasked with the implementation of social infrastructure projects on behalf of the Gauteng Provincial Government. This includes the planning, design, construction, refurbishment, and upgrading of clinics, hospitals, schools, libraries, early childhood development centres, and other social facilities. Additionally, the Department manages a portfolio of public facilities valued at over R40 billion and coordinates the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) in collaboration with sister departments and municipalities, contributing to job creation and skills development within communities.

CoGTA plays a vital role in supporting municipalities to create an environment conducive to economic growth. Its primary responsibility is to strengthen municipalities in line with Section 154 of the Constitution. Furthermore, CoGTA provides both financial and non-financial support to Traditional Councils to enhance their capacity and enable them to fulfil their functions effectively.
