Gauteng Government Targets Constitution Hill for CBD Friday Cleanup

The Gauteng Provincial Government's CBD Friday initiative, aimed at revitalising Central Business Districts (CBDs) across the province, continues to gain momentum. This week, the focus shifts to Constitution Hill in the heart of Johannesburg.

Following multiple successful activations last year, the next CBD Friday cleanup will take place on Friday, 31 January 2025. Activities will include litter removal, streetlight repairs, enhanced safety and security interventions, and social services support for communities in the area.

Spearheaded by the Gauteng Provincial Government, in partnership with the **South African Local Government Association (SALGA)** the **City of Johannesburg (CoJ) Metropolitan Municipality** and civil movement **Jozi My Jozi**, this initiative forms part of the broader CBD Revitalisation Programme launched on 30 August 2024. The programme aims to tackle crime and urban decay while improving lighting, security, and cleanliness to create an environment that attracts investment.
