GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 14 July 2021 sits at 792 130 with 699 717 recoveries and 14 867 deaths.

A total number of 9208 people are currently hospitalised in the public (3526) and private (5682) facilities.

As of 11 July 2021, 1 302 081 people have been registered on the Electronic Vaccination Data System. A total of 883 934 people have been vaccinated in the province as at 11 July 2021.

- The unallocated cases reflected in the sub-district breakdown refer to cases confirmed in that district but have not been allocated to a subdistrict.

Data Harmonisation

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies, provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD), we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a particular district.
