GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 19 July 2021 sits at 818 859 with 751 803 recoveries and 15 482 deaths.

A total number of 8565 people are currently hospitalised in the public (3393) and private (5172) facilities.

A total of 1 285 639 people have been vaccinated in the province as at 19 July 2021. As of Monday, 19 July 2021, 1 868 046 people have been registered on the Electronic Vaccination Data System.

- The unallocated cases reflected in the sub-district breakdown refer to cases confirmed in that district but have not been allocated to a subdistrict.

Data Harmonisation

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies, provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD), we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a particular district.
