#### **GAUTENG PARTNERS WITH SAB TO VACCINATE FACTORY EMPLOYEES IN ROSSLYN AND SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES**

The Gauteng Provincial Government's drive to vaccinate 10 million people by December 2021 continues to gain momentum and support from social partners, and the business community.

As part of taking the vaccination drive to the people, the Gauteng MEC for Health, Dr Nomathemba Mokgethi together with Tshwane Executive Mayor Councillor Randall Williams and Member of the Mayoral Committee for Health Councillor Sakkie Du Plooy will join the work-based vaccination drive at the South African Breweries (SAB) in Rosslyn, Pretoria on Wednesday, 15 September 2021.

This programme will see a walk-in pop-up vaccination site open on 15 and 16 September 2021, to allow SAB staff, nearby businesses, and the surrounding communities to get vaccinated.

With the threat of the expected fourth wave, partnerships like this between the Gauteng Provincial Government and employers like SAB will help in accelerating the vaccination rollout programme to offer protection to as many people as possible. Vaccination has proven to be effective in minimising severe illness, hospitalisation and death in the event that one contracts the coronavirus.
