Gauteng Health to handover books to Covid-19 patients and frontline staff at the Spiritual Assistance programme

As part of ongoing efforts to give hope and motivate healthcare workers in the frontline against the fight to defeat Covid-19, the Gauteng Department of Health will handover books, bibles and other items to staff, as a token of appreciation on Thursday.

The books will also be handed out to Covid-19 patients that are currently in isolation and quarantine sites across the province and those that are in admission in hospitals.
