GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 21 May 2020 sits at 2453, with 1776 recoveries and 27 deaths.

Out of a total of 13 442 contacts traced (these are individuals who were in contact with people who tested positive for COVID-19); 8560 people have completed the 14 days monitoring period with no symptoms reported and therefore they are de-isolated.

A total number of 70 people are currently hospitalized in the public and private facility.

- The unallocated cases reflected in the sub-district breakdown refer to cases confirmed in that district but have not been allocated to a subdistrict.

Data Harmonization

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies, provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD), we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a particular district.
