GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 24 May 2020 sits at 2773, with 1899 recoveries and 29 deaths.

Out of a total of 11 699 contacts traced (these are individuals who were in contact with people who tested positive for COVID-19); 9040 people have completed the 14 days monitoring period with no symptoms reported and therefore they are de-isolated.

A total number of 103 people are currently hospitalized in the public and private facility.

UPDATE ON COVID-19 CASES AT ANGLO GOLD ASHANTI MINE IN MERAUFONG

The Gauteng Department of Health (GDoH) can confirm 164 positive cases of COVID-19 at Anglo Gold Ashanti Mponeng mine in Merafong sub-district.

The outbreak team were dispatched to trace all known contacts, the process of contact tracing is ongoing. This would be accompanied by an intensified screening and testing campaign in the area.

MEC Bandile Masuku and the Gauteng Health team met with the mine management yesterday afternoon to receive report from the mine, and to ensure that there is swift response in the management of the cases.

The GDoH has made available three of the quarantine/isolation facilities, NASREC Transnet (Esselen Park) and Eskom to accommodate some of positive cases.

Underground production in the mine remains closed until further notice.

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies, provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD), we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a particular district.
