GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 15 May 2020 sits at 2210, with 1583 recoveries and 24 deaths.

Out of a total of 10253 contacts traced (these are individuals who were in contact with people who tested positive for COVID-19); 8133 people have completed the 14 days monitoring period with no symptoms reported and therefore they are de-isolated.

A total number of 54 people are currently hospitalized in the public and private facility.

in that district but have not been allocated to a subdistrict.

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further

information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies,

provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD),

we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a

particular district.
