GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 02 May 2020 sits at 1598, with 979 recoveries and 12 deaths.

Out of a total of 8667 contacts traced (these are individuals who were in contact with people who tested positive for COVID-19); 5919 people have completed the 14 days monitoring period with no symptoms reported and therefore they are de-isolated.

A total number of 70 people are currently hospitalized in the public and private facility.

information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies,

provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD),

we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a

particular district.
