GAUTENG ADMINISTERED VACCINATIONS DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

A total of 6 000 964 COVID-19 vaccinations have been administered in the province as at 31 October 2021.

As at 31 October 2021 a total number of individuals vaccinated is 3 935 877 and individuals fully vaccinated sits at 3 028 010
