GAUTENG REACHES ANOTHER MILESTONE OF OVER FOUR MILLION VACCINES ADMINISTERED

The Gauteng Provincial Government is encouraged with another milestone of having administered 4 027 473 vaccines. Of that figure the province has 1 824 754 people who are fully vaccinated, meaning they have taken both doses of the Pfizer vaccine or a single JnJ vaccine.

This milestone comes at the time when Gauteng province is intensifying efforts to get as many people as possible vaccinated to beat the anticipated fourth wave later at the end of this year.

The province continues to ramp-up the vaccination programme through on-going partnership with private sector, media, civil organisations and faith based organisations. Additional vaccination sites, including POP-UP vaccination sites, and those operating over the weekend are being opened to accommodate those who are unable to get vaccinated during the week, and to take the vaccines to the people.

Vaccination has been proven to be effective in minimising severe illness, hospitalisation and death in the event one contracts the coronavirus.

All persons who are 18 years and older are invited to visit their nearest vaccination site to get vaccinated. The public is further reminded that those who received a two-dose vaccine need to return for the second dose at 42 days.

All Gauteng sites both private and public accept walk-ins whether people are registered on the EVDS or not.

GAUTENG CONFIRMED COVID-19 CASES DISTRICT BREAKDOWN

The total number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Gauteng as at 15 September 2021 sits at 912 729 with 889 924 recoveries and 19 102 deaths.

A total number of 2665 people are currently hospitalised in the public (1032) and private (1633) facilities.

A total of 4 027 473 vaccines have been administered in the province as at 15 September 2021.

Allocating Gauteng cases to respective districts is ongoing. After obtaining further information on contact numbers and addresses from law enforcement agencies, provincial outbreak teams and the National Institute of Communicable Disease (NICD), we are able to make corrections where a case might have been incorrectly allocated to a particular district.
