# GAUTENG INTENSIFIES FOCUS ON VACCINATION TO BEAT FOURTH WAVE

The Gauteng Provincial Government continues to work with various sectors of society towards vaccinating as many people as possible to beat the fourth wave and ahead of the festive period.

To achieve the goal to get more jabs in the arms of people efforts targeting areas in the province with low vaccine uptake have been intensified.

In keeping with the set goal, the Gauteng Department of Health will as of today release daily vaccination roll out stats as a way of encouraging eligible people to prioritise getting the jab. It is only when 70% or more of the adult population is vaccinated by mid-December that we can minimise the impact of the fourth wave and avoid stricter restrictions.

The public is notified that the daily COVID-19 data will now be released once as part of the weekly media update on COVID-19.

A total of 5 021 958 vaccinations have been administered in the province as at 08 October 2021 with 3 484 007 individuals vaccinated of which 2 400 649 are fully vaccinated.
