#### **GAUTENG ADMINISTERED VACCINATIONS DISTRICT BREAKDOWN**

A total of 5 107 436 COVID-19 vaccinations have been administered in the province as at 11 October 2021.

As at 11 October 2021 a total number of individuals vaccinated is 3 523 373 and individuals fully vaccinated sits at 2 458 299.
