NEW ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE TO LEAD TO IMPROVED SERVICE DELIVERY BY GAUTENG HEALTH

The Gauteng Department of Health (GDoH) at the beginning of the 6th Administration adopted a vision that puts patients at the centre of its day to day work through the pursuit of a "responsive, value-based and people centred health care system".

To realise this goal the department embarked on a process to revise its organisational structure so that it is aligned to meet organisational priorities.

The process is now at an advanced stage and with the department currently undergoing consultations with relevant stakeholders in order to get the revised structure in place before the end of the financial year.

Previously, delays were experienced in finalising this process due to several dependencies, such as completing the service delivery model by Branch Heads, non-alignment to the generic guidelines provided by the Department of Public Service and Administration (DPSA), and the protracted consultation process with various stakeholders.

However, following the 2019-2024 strategic development plan, the organisational structure was reviewed, and is presently being subjected to final consultations with relevant stakeholders. The Department envisages that the review and approval of the Organisational Structure will be completed by the end of the current financial year.
