**MEC Maile to visit Mhlahla family**

MEC for Human Settlements, Urban Planning and CoGTA Lebogang Maile will visit the Mhlahla family tomorrow Friday September 17, 2021, at 10h00am, in Attridgeville, outside City of Tshwane.

An internal investigation in April 2021 revealed that the Mhlahla family home was illegally demolished by Red Ants. MEC Maile after being alerted of Mhlahla's ordeal immediately directed Departmental officials to prioritise the re-construction of the house.

The newly-built house will be handed-over to the Mhlahla family by Gauteng Government. MEC Maile will be accompanied by senior Departmental officials and Ward 8 Councillor Sam Mashala.
