MEC Maile and Mayor Matongo to visit South Hills

MEC for Human Settlements, Urban Planning and CoGTA Lebogang Maile and City of Johannesburg's Executive Mayor Cllr. Jolidee Matongo will visit South Hills, City of Johannesburg, tomorrow Sunday 5 September 2021.

The visit by MEC Maile and Mayor Matongo is a result of a protest march by residents of South Hills complaining about the quality of their houses and inadequate access to basic services, such as water and electricity. South Hills is a Gauteng Government funded mixed human settlement project, initiated in 2016 in the City of Johannesburg. Tomorrow's visit will allow MEC Maile and Mayor Matongo to inspect the affected houses and explore interventions.
