## MEC MAILE TO HANDOVER A HOUSE TO SURVIVORS

## 11 May 2022

Late last year, 10 November 2022, a house in Pretoria West was engulfed in a blaze of fire that left five family members of the same household dead. With the assistance of a private company, a house has been generously built for the family.

MEC for Human Settlements, Urban Planning and CoGTA Lebogang Maile visited the affected family after the blaze to offer Government's condolences and to understand the underlying causes of the blaze. A commitment was then made by MEC Maile and the Gauteng Provincial Government to help the family with burials and a new shelter.

MEC Maile will tomorrow, Thursday 12 May 2022, handover a newly-built house to the family. The handover will commence at 10 am, Soshanguve, North of Pretoria, City of Tshwane.
