### **MEC MOTARA TO HANDOVER HOUSES AND LAUNCH NEW STUDENT ACCOMODATION PROJECT**

MEC for Human Settlements in Gauteng, Tasneem Motara, will continue on 28 November 2024 to handover government subsidised houses to those most in need, in different regions, as part of the 16 days campaign against Gender Based Violence, this time in Soshanguve Block MM, Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality.

The MEC kick-started the campaign this week in Helderwyk Mega Human Settlements project, where she handed over 10 houses to GBV victims, people living with disabilities and child-headed homes. The MEC will tomorrow proceed to Soshanguve Block MM, where she will hand over houses and 380 title deeds to deserving beneficiaries.

This campaign reaffirms government's stance against abuse and its commitment to assist those most in need. It is not merely a formality; it is a clarion call for action to stand against abuse of any form.

On the same day, the MEC will also launch Ha Bo Rona Student Accommodation with 77 units and 308 beds at no. 459 Hanny St, Pretoria Gardens, Pretoria.
