### **MEC Tasneem Motara to hand over 400 title deeds and 200 rapid land release certificates in the Westrand.**

The MEC for Human Settlements in the Gauteng Province will tomorrow handover 400 title deeds in Khutsong South to government housing beneficiaries. A title deed is a proof of ownership that also allows people to use their homes to participate in the economy.

MEC Motara will proceed to the Elijah Barayi Mega Human Settlements project and hand over 200 certificates to beneficiaries of the Departments Ikagaleng Rapid Land Release programme. The Ikagaleng Rapid Land Release programme targets beneficiaries who do not qualify for RDP houses, can build for themselves and who earn between R3501 and R7000 per month.

The beneficiaries are allocated stands that have services that include, electricity, water and sewer infrastructure and five building plans that have been approved by the municipality. The beneficiaries are expected to build on the stands within five years.
