Gauteng to officially open newly constructed testing centre in Kagiso

Gauteng MEC for Roads and Transport, Dr Ismail Vadi together with MEC for Infrastructure Development, Jacob Mamabolo, will on Monday, 08 April 2019, officially open the newly constructed Driver Learner Testing Centre (DLTC) in Kagiso, Mogale City.

The MECs will be joined by Mogale City Executive Mayor Patrick Lipudi as well as local councillors.

Constructed at a cost of R24 million, the Kagiso DLTC is a Grade D centre providing services that include applications for learners' licenses, driver testing, motor vehicle registration and license renewals. This is in line with the Provincial Government's commitment to bring public services closer to communities.

The centre will further provide fully online and cashless services as the Provincial Government explore ways to take advantage of benefits of the Fourth Industrial Revolution.
