Having matriculated at Badirile High School in 1985, Honourable Mokgethi has served in different structures of the ANC and the ANC Women's League in Merafong sub-region of the West Rand.

From 2007 to 2008 she served as Deputy Chairperson of the then southern district region.

Also in 2007 to 2008 she served as Provincial Executive Committee (PEC) member of ANC Women's League in the North West.

In 2009 she served as Regional Executive Committee (REC) member of ANC Women's League in the West Rand

In 2012 to 2019 she served as Provincial Treasurer of the ANC Women's League in Gauteng.

She currently serves in the Regional Executive Committee (REC) of SANCO in the West Rand Region since 2019.

She has overseen the Sedibeng Constituency since 2018.

She served in the fifth Legislature as MPL from 2018 serving in the following Portfolio Committees, Health, Scopa, Ad Hoc Committee of Money Bill, Economic and Rural Development and as a Constituency Whip.

She was appointed to the Presidential Review Committee in 2018 to contribute on the 25 years since democracy report focusing on Progress and Challenges for Gender Equality and Women Emancipation, a report that was finalized in 2019.

She is currently serving in the sixth Legislature which started in 2019 as an MPL and as MEC for Social Development, a role she assume in 2020.

She has extensive knowledge which includes 27-year experience in local government.

In 2011 to 2012 she served as Acting Municipal Manager in Merafong.

From 2017 to 2019 she served as Municipal Manager in Tlokwe and in 2014 -2017 at JB Marks Amalgamated Municipality.

She was nominated for the MEC Local Government awards under the Service Delivery category in 2005.

In 2006 she received an award for best performing Department within Merafong City Local Municipality. It was during this period that she steered the erstwhile Tlokwe City Council to three consecutive unqualified audits. She also helped the erstwhile Tlokwe and Ventersdorp municipalities to amalgamate in 2017.

In the financial years 2014/2015 and 2015/2016 she earned the municipality acknowledgement for its consistent good performance amongst the best in the country and second to none in our province.

She holds a Diploma in Nursing which she obtained at Tshepong Hospital (Klerksdorp) in 1993.

She also has a BA in nursing from Potchefstroom University (North West University), which she completed in 1998.

In 2004 she obtained a Masters' in Nursing Science from the University of South Africa.
