**THE COMMISSION OF INQUIRY INTO TAXI VIOLENCE CONTINUES
ON 03 FEBRUARY 2020**

The public hearings of the Commission of Inquiry into Taxi Violence in the Gauteng province will continue on Monday, 03 February 2020 at 10:00.

The Commission will hear testimony from the Gauteng Department of Roads and Transport's Acting Chief Director: Registration and Operating Licensing, Mr Modise Sojane, from Monday, 03 February, until Wednesday, 05 February 2020, at 10:00.

Mr Sojane's testimony will include, but not be limited to:

- Historical context to the provision of Public Transport services by the Minibus taxi industry in Gauteng; and
- Historical context - How the Law regulating the Taxi Industry has evolved over time including how the minibus taxi industry is structured, governed, managed and regulated.

The legal team is in the process of identifying and/or consulting with other witnesses who will appear before the Commission over the next few weeks.
