Gauteng partners with AngloGold Ashanti to flatten the Covid-19 curve in Public Transport

The Gauteng Provincial Government will partner with AngloGold Ashanti to provide water tanks in Hammanskraal taxi ranks as part of efforts to flatten the Coronavirus (COVID-19) curve.

The Water Tanks donated by AngloGold Ashanti, will be handed over to identified priority taxi ranks in the province by MEC Jacob Mamabolo as part of improving hygiene to combat the spread of the virus in public transport nodes.
