Gauteng engages private property developers to report progress on the delivery of Transport Infrastructure to support their developments

Gauteng MEC for Public Transport and Roads Infrastructure, Jacob Mamabolo, will on Thursday, 10 March 2022, kick-start engagements with private property developers to report progress on the delivery of Transport Infrastructure to support their developments.
