MEC Diale-Tlabela to hand over Phase 1 of Vereeniging Intermodal Facility

Gauteng MEC for Transport and Logistics, Kedibone Diale-Tlabela, will on Friday, 11 August 2023, hand over a fully completed Vereeniging Intermodal Facility to the taxi industry in Vereeniging and surrounding towns in the Sedibeng District Municipality.

The handing over of the facility forms part of the Department's commitment to fast track delivery of critical transport infrastructure projects.

It also serves in restoring and growing the economy, providing access to economic and much-needed job opportunities.

Phase 1 of the project, which commenced on 08 December 2022, consisted of refurbishing the existing taxi rank to include new hawker stalls, loading shelters and ablution facilities.

The refurbishment also included undertaking electrical works, revamping surface drainage systems and access ways.

The Department had appointed the Gautrain Management Agency (GMA) as the implementing agent for the delivery of the intermodal facility.
