**MEC Mamabolo to launch a joint Road Safety Campaign with the taxi industry**

Gauteng MEC for Public Transport and Roads Infrastructure Jacob Mamabolo will be partnering with the two major provincial minibus taxi associations, the South African National Taxi Council (SANTACO) and National Taxi Alliance (NTA) to launch *Hlokomela–Ndlelanhle*, the province's Road Safety Campaign, in Grasmere Toll Plaza, South of Johannesburg.

The joint programme is part of a Memorandum of Understanding signed by the Department and the two associations for the taxi industry to take a lead spreading the message of road safety in Gauteng.

The department and its partners will be taking the *Hlokomela–Ndlelanhle* campaign throughout all developmental corridors of the province, raising awareness on road safety, as part of changing the behaviour of road users.
