Public Advisory Notice: Partial closure of Weirda Road near N14 Freeway due to a possible sinkhole

Motorists are hereby advised to avoid Weirda Road near the N14 Freeway due to a possible developing sinkhole in the City of Tshwane.

As a precautionary measure, both sections of the road have been partially closed to traffic.

Partial road closures are as follows:

- 1. M10 / (K103) Solomon Mahlangu/ Wierda Road between Ashwood Dr and M24 (to Valhalla by Sasol Garage)
- 2.On-ramp access to Laudium and Sunderland Ridge

Alternative roads to be used are:

- 1. M34 (Jean Avenue)
- 2. M24 to Valhalla (Snake valley Road)
- 3. M18 Botha Ave linking the R101 Old Joburg Road

The closure is expected to be in effect for the foreseeable future as engineers and officials will be conducting investigations.
