MEC Nkomo-Ralehoko to visit the communities of West Rand

MEC for Finance and e-Government Ms Nomantu Nkomo-Ralehoko will take economic opportunities and ICT Skills Development Programme to the communities of the West Rand on Tuesday, 25 May 2021. The MEC's visit to the West Rand forms part of an outreach programme targeted at various regions of Gauteng aimed at bringing government services closer to the people.

During her time in West Rand (Kagiso), the MEC will launch an ICT Skills Development Programme for 100 young people. This ICT Programme is designed to introduce young people in the ICT sector, provide them with soft skills training, and to mitigate skills shortage in the sector.

The MEC will also engage the communities on public sector procurement requirements, economic opportunities and educate the township entrepreneurs on how to register on Central Supplier Database.

On-site vendor registrations and e-invoicing will also be conducted. Entrepreneurs should bring the follow documents in order to be registered electronically on the e-supplier registration platform; a certified I.D. copy, CK number, original & valid Tax Clearance Certificate and proof of a bank account
